We would like to invite all parents and carers to our fortnightly coffee mornings.


Coffee mornings start at **9am.** Free tea, coffee and biscuits are provided.

#### School Attendance

Last week our overall school attendance was 92%. If your child is unwell, you *must* call the school office on 0117 377 2080, every day by 9am, to let us know, leaving your child's name and class.

Polite reminder: All parents and carers have a responsibility to get their children into school on time, by 8:45, each day. If your child arrives late, this will be marked on the register. Arrival after 9:10am will be considered an unauthorised absence and may be subject to a Penalty Notice. Penalty notices are a fine of £60 per child, per adult.

Unfortunately we are unable to authorise holidays during term time. If you take your child away during term time, they will be marked as unauthorized, and you may face a Penalty Notice. If you *are* planning on going away, you must complete a holiday request form. If your child doesn't attend school and we have not been given a reason, the school are obliged to contact Education Welfare, who will investigate your child's absence.




In an emergency always contact the police by dialing 999.
