Summary of learning in Term 1

Authors

Stories: Recap familiar stories from Reception in story time. Introduce a new story called Dogger. Then move on to traditional tales with a focus of Goldilocks and the three bears.

Phonics: Revise Phase 2 and 3 sounds that the children learnt in Reception. Focus on oral segmenting and blending. Familiarise the children with the phonics lesson structure with a focus on application of phonics skills to reading. Once we have revised phase 2, 3 and 4, we will move onto learning Phase 5.

Writing: Practise fine motor skills and pencil grip, learn letter formation, letter families and capital letters.

Throughout the year we will focus on language devel-

Religious Education

We will be exploring 'Why are some places special?' and learning about special places for Christians and Muslims including churches and mosques.

Learning for life

This term we will be focusing on: Being Me in my World.

We will also be playing circle games and playground
games to work on our collaboration.

We will also be learning about Black History Month.

Art

We will be focusing on spirals. Working on pencil control, experimenting with different mediums (pencil, chalk, paint) and looking for spirals all around us.

PE

In our PE lessons we will be focussing on fundamentals such as agility, balance and co-ordination during our indoor sessions.

During our outdoor sessions, we will be focusing on ball skills. Moving around confidently

Computing

We will be learning about E- safety. Thinking about how to keep ourselves safe online and which adults we can talk to

Maths

We will be focusing on Place Value to 10 using practical resources to count objects, match numbers, know one more than and one less than as well as comparing and ordering numbers.

We will be focussing on number formation and matching objects, numbers and words. We will further the children's learning through their play as well as by using

Enquiry

We will be answering the question:

How do children play now and in the past?

Learning about different toys and games from the past, sharing our favourite toys, learning about how the internet has changed how children play. We will be interviewing someone, comparing toys from the past and now and finishing with making a toy in DT

Music

We will be learning about pitch and rhythm using the hip hop song 'Hey You!'
