Summary of learning in Term 2

Authors

Stories: Walking through the jungle – We will be learning the story through songs and actions.

Phonics: Learning Phase 5 sounds and introducing alternate sounds.

Writing: Write about a recount of our Welly walk. Consolidate simple sentence writing using capital letters and full stops.

Religious Education

We will be exploring 'Why are some places special?' and learning about special places for Christians and Muslims including churches and mosques.

Learning for life

This term we will be reflecting on 'Celebrating Differences' We will also be playing circle games and playground games based around respect and trust.

Art

We will be focusing on spirals. Working on pencil control, experimenting with different mediums (pencil, chalk, paint) and looking for spirals all around us.

ΡE

In our PE lessons we will be focusing on fundamentals such as agility, balance and co-ordination during our outdoor sessions.

Inside we will be learning dance skills, so that we can perform a dance using simple movement patterns.

Computing

We will be learning about technology around us. Children learn what technology means and different places around us where technology is used.

Maths

We will be focusing on Addition and Subtraction within 10.

Using practical resources to count objects and create number sentences.

We will further the children's learning through their play as well as by using chants, songs and rhymes. Towards the end of the term, we will be exploring shape.

Enquiry

We will be answering the question:

How do we use everyday materials?

We will be exploring different materials practically such as wood, glass, metal, plastic and water. We will also be exploring their properties such as dull, hard, smooth or rough.

Music

We will be learning about pitch and rhythm using the hip hop song 'Hey You!'
