# Sticky knowledge

Plants need water, light and warmth to grow and stay healthy.

Most plants produce seeds which grow into new plants. Different types of plants can grow from different types of seeds.

Healthy plants grow strong and upright. An unhealthy plant can be dry, dull, brown or yellow in colour and unable to stand upright.

The growth of plants over time can be observed and recorded in different ways.
