School Attendance

We are unable to authorise holidays during term time. If you take your child away during term time, they will be marked as unauthorised, and you may face a Penalty Notice. This includes taking them out of school ahead of the summer holidays, or failing to return on time in September.

If you *are* planning on going away, you must complete a holiday request form. If your child doesn't attend school and we have not been given a reason, the school are obliged to contact our Child Missing Education Welfare Officer, who will investigate your child's absence - and you would still receive a Penalty Notice.

Communication with school is important and can prevent unnecessary fines and prosecutions.

If you are travelling to a country affected by FGM, at anytime during the summer, you may be questioned at the airport about the nature of your trip. We encourage you to attend an FGM support meeting with school ahead of your travels, where we can provide you with information as well as a letter of support from the school.
